December 16, 2013

The Board of Aldermen, City of Kearney, Missouri, met in regular session at Kearney City Hall, 100 East Washington, December 16, 2013 at 6:30 P.M. with Mayor Dane presiding. Members present were Jeff Couchman, Dan Holt, Gerri Spencer and Tom Patterson. Staff members present were Jim Eldridge, David Pavlich, Jay Bettis and Shirley Zimmerman.

Mayor Dane opened the meeting with the Pledge of the Allegiance.

MAYOR'S REMARKS

Mayor Dane said due to weather the Mayor's Christmas Tree Lighting was cancelled. The Chamber of Commerce coloring contest winners were to be recognized so they are here tonight to be recognized.

Mayor Dane and Chamber of Commerce President, Debbie Holt presented Certificates and prizes to the winners of the Coloring Contest.

ROD WILL PRESENTATION OF FUNDS FOR KEARNEY WRESTLING AND

<u>AUTISM WORKS</u> Rod Will said it was on his bucket list of things to do for him to wrestle someone. He said the idea grew into a fund raiser benefit. He said he was donating the money made to Kearney Wrestling program and Autism Works.

Mr. Will and Mayor Dane presented checks for \$425 each to Chad Hopkins, Kearney Wrestling and Dusary Klarilund, Autism Works.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

STATUS OF AMI WATER METER INSTALLATION PROJECT Jay Bettis, City Water Superintendent, said HD Supply and Sensus, the City's water meter vendors have gotten all the meters installed.

Mr. Bettis said the installer had made a list of parts to return. He said we have also downsized several meters which will result in a big savings. He said the installation was excellent. We just have to now get all the software up and running to complete the project.

<u>CRETCHER HEARTLAND INSURANCE QUOTES</u> Staff reported that Rex Sweetwood, Cretcher Heartland has delivered unexpected news of the City's property insurance more than doubling in cost.

Staff said we will be working with Cretcher Heartland on alternative options and will have a special meeting on December 30th at 6:30 P.M.

ELECTION FILING Staff reported that the filing for the April Election will open at 8:00 A.M. on Tuesday, December 17, 2013. Alderman Spencer and Alderman Patterson are both up for re-election.

<u>CITY HALL CHRISTMAS PARTY</u> Staff invited everyone to come to City Hall, December 24th at 10:00 A.M. for Christmas Brunch. The City will supply ham and everyone brings a covered dish.

<u>SUPPORT FOR CLEARPATH SENIOR HOLDINGS</u> A Resolution of intent to <u>RESOLUTION NO.35-2013</u> support an application by Clearpath Senior Holdings to the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the construction of senior assisted living facility at the corner of 33 Highway and Meadowbrook Drive, was presented and read by Title only.

Jeff Bender, Clearpath Senior Holdings, said he is the Co Founder and principle holder in the company. He said they are looking to market areas outside of larger cities and under served for this type of housing.

Mr. Bender said they have been working for a year on this project. He said financing is not an issue. They simply look for communities who will be behind a project like this. He said they are currently building one in Maryville, Missouri. He said he will have a partner who will operate the facility.

Alderman Couchman asked if he would own the building and then lease it to the operator. Mr. Bender said the operator invests in the building and gets a management fee.

Alderman Patterson asked how they determine if you get approved. Mr. Bender said it's not as difficult as the senior housing programs. He said they just want to limit the number of private pay facilities so they are done correctly and can survive.

SUPPORT FOR CLEARPATH SENIOR HOLDINGS Alderman Holt asked what **RESOLUTION NO 35-2013** type of care they would be offering. Mr. Bender said facilities can provide residential, assisted and skilled nursing. He said they will each have their own living space. They will be provided with help with feeding, bathing, etc. if needed. He said they will have a bus to get them to activities. He said you can apply for hospice service in their facility and they will be permitted to enter the facility.

Alderman Spencer asked what the age range would be. Mr. Bender said typically the age is 75 plus and most will be between 80 and 85.

A motion was made by Alderman Patterson and seconded by Alderman Spencer to approve the Resolution of intent to support an application by Clearpath Senior Holdings to the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the construction of senior assisted living facility at the corner of 33 Highway and Meadowbrook Drive. The motion carried unanimously.

SOHAIL ANWAR, APPLICATION FOR PACKAGE LIQUOR LICENSE

Staff presented an application for a package liquor license for a new store proposed to be located at 196 West 92 Highway in Kearney Commercial Center.

Staff said the applicant has a 3rd degree assault misdemeanor charge. Staff presented a statement of the circumstances emailed by the applicant. The Police Department obtained the St. Joseph Police Department investigation report that was used by the prosecution in obtaining the plea bargain agreement.

Mayor Dane asked if there was a recommendation from the Police Chief. Staff said we don't have a signature from the Police Chief.

Mayor Dane said he didn't believe we should move forward until the Police Chief has said he approves the application.

Alderman Couchman said we have had applicants who haven't been the owner at other places. He said maybe he can have someone else be the manager.

Alderman Patterson said there is a spot on the application for the Police Chief to sign and he feels like it should be signed.

Alderman Spencer said she thought we should table this until the Police Chief signs off on it.

Alderman Patterson asked if the police pulled the records. Staff said yes, but they didn't know who from the department might have pulled the records.

A motion was made by Alderman Spencer and seconded by Alderman Couchman to table the application for a package liquor license for a new store proposed to be located at 196 West 92 Highway in Kearney Commercial Center until December 30th meeting and the

Police Chief has signed off on the application. The motion carried by a vote of three to one with Alderman Patterson voting nay.

ZONING AMENDMENT VEHICLE SALES SPACING REQUIREMENTS ORDINANCE NO. 1232-2013 Bill No. 23-2013, an ordinance amending the Zoning Ordinance pertaining to minimum spacing of vehicle sales or rental allowed as a Conditional Use in Commercial and Industrial Districts, was presented and read by Title only.

Staff reported that the City was approached by potential applicant Chris Riley, who would like to locate a used car lot on his property at Lawrence and 33 Highway, but can't meet the current spacing.

Staff said by reducing the minimum spacing it would bring several existing properties into compliance with the ordinance, eliminating their non-conforming use status.

Alderman Holt said the Planning and Zoning Commission had a lengthy discussion about this and want to be able to promote business in the community. The vote was four to one with the person voting nay because they didn't see a reason for the change.

The floor was opened to the public.

There being no comments from the public, the floor was closed.

Alderman Patterson asked what the distance was before the 1500 feet was passed. Staff said there were no limits.

A motion was made by Alderman Holt and seconded by Alderman Spencer to approve the ordinance as read on the first reading. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Alderman Patterson and seconded by Alderman Couchman to place Bill No. 23-2013 on its second and final reading. Said Bill was thereupon read and considered, and was duly passed by the following roll call vote: Voting for the Motion: Patterson, Spencer, Holt and Couchman. The motion carried unanimously. The Bill was then duly numbered **Ordinance No. 1232-2013**.

ACCEPTING RIVER MEADOWS LAND ADJACENT TO CITY TRAIL

RESOLUTION NO. 36-2013 A Resolution, accepting a dedication of land near River Meadows to the City from Sadenco, Inc. and River Meadows, LLC, was presented and read by Title only.

Staff said Bill Denman has offered to deed the remaining parcels of ground owned by Sadenco, Inc. and River Meadows, LLC if the City would pay the 2012 and 2013 taxes, which total \$334.30.

ACCEPTING RIVER MEADOWS LAND ADJACENT TO CITY TRAIL

RESOLUTION NO. 36-2013 The Sadenco parcel is the 23 acres which include the River Meadow lake adjacent to the City trail. The River Meadows LLC property is an 8.8 acre tract along Fishing River also adjacent to the City Trail.

Staff said this is an opportunity to preserve the land, which is all within the flood plain and would be allowed to remain wild and unmaintained, as has been done since River Meadows development.

Jay Bettis, Water Superintendent, said this would be a good buffer for the sewer plant.

A motion was made by Alderman Holt and seconded by Alderman Patterson to approve the Resolution accepting a dedication of land near River Meadows to the City from Sadenco, Inc. and River Meadows, LLC. The motion carried unanimously.

<u>ALLOWING PROOF OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY BY ELECTRONIC</u> <u>DEVICE</u> Bill No. 24-2013, an ordinance allowing proof of financial responsibility

ORDINANCE NO. 1233-2013 by display on a mobile electronic device, was presented and read by Title only.

Staff reported that this adopts new State Statute language that permits a citizen to use their smart phone or other such electronic device to demonstrate they have auto insurance.

Alderman Holt said in the future he would like for a representative of the Police Department to be here if we have something in regard to changing policy for the Police Department.

A motion was made by Alderman Couchman and seconded by Alderman Patterson to approve the ordinance as read on the first reading. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Alderman Holt and seconded by Alderman Spencer to place Bill No. 24-2013 on its second and final reading. Said Bill was thereupon read and considered, and was duly passed by the following roll call vote: Voting for the Motion: Patterson, Spencer, Holt and Couchman. The motion carried unanimously. MoDOT AGREEMENT FOR COST APPORTIONMENT RELATIVE TO 33 HWY & MEADOWBROOK DRIVE TURN LANE PROJECT 4P3047

ORDINANCE NO. 1234-2013 Bill NO 25-2913, an ordinance authorizing the Mayor to sign Cost Apportionment Agreement with MoDOT relative to the Meadowbrook Drive Turn Lane Project as part of MoDOT Project 4P3407, was presented and read by Title only.

MoDOT AGREEMENT FOR COST APPORTIONMENT RELATIVE TO 33 HWY & MEADOWBROOK DRIVE TURN LANE PROJECT 4P3047

ORDINANCE NO. 1234-2013 Staff said the revised agreement with MoDOT actually reduces the City's liability for the project. In the prior agreement the City was to contribute \$61,000 plus ROW acquisition and utility relocation expenses (estimated to be \$28,000).

Staff said the new agreement, negotiated by David Pavlich and Shelie Daniel, limits the City's obligation to the specific amount of \$64,331, of which \$51,454 will come from the City's Small Urban Funding allotment leaving the City to pay \$12,866.

A motion was made by Alderman Patterson and seconded by Alderman Holt to approve the ordinance as read on the first reading. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Alderman Spencer and seconded by Alderman Couchman to place Bill No. 25-2013 on its second and final reading. Said Bill was thereupon read and considered, and was duly passed by the following roll call vote: Voting for the Motion: Patterson, Spencer, Holt and Couchman. The motion carried unanimously. The Bill was then duly numbered **Ordinance No. 1234-2013**.

Staff said we will also need to amend the budget by authorizing the \$12,866 to be paid from the Highway Construction Fund.

A motion was made by Alderman Patterson and seconded by Alderman Holt to amend the budget by authorizing the \$12,866 to be paid from the Highway Construction Fund. The motion carried unanimously.

ALDERMEN DISCUSSION

ALDERMAN SPENCER Alderman Spencer said she wanted to wish everyone a Merry Christmas.

<u>ALDERMAN HOLT</u> Alderman Holt said, if we are going to pursue purchasing the old Methodist Church, we should be getting bids for the cost to pave the empty lot next door to help with parking.

Staff said the legal description is going to be very difficult and expensive to obtain for the old Church building so that is on a hold. They said we can use quotes from the curb project done on Prospect Street if we want to pave the lot.

ADJOURNMENT There being no further business on the agenda, a motion was made by Alderman Couchman and seconded by Alderman Patterson to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.
