The Kearney Special Road District of Clay County, City of Kearney, Missouri, met in regular session at Kearney City Hall, 100 East Washington, February 18, 2010 at 6:30 P.M. with Bill Duncan presiding. Member present was Jim Thomas. Chuck Davis was absent. City Staff present were Jim Eldridge and Shirley Zimmerman.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES** A motion was made by Jim Thomas and seconded by Bill Duncan to approve the December 17, 2009 meeting as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

**ADMINISTRATOR’S REPORT**

**WRITE IN ELECTION** Staff reported that it was an over sight by the City to notify Bill Duncan that he need to file for election this year. There will have to be a “write in only” election held and it will cost for the election.

Bill Duncan asked who has to pay for the election. Staff said the bill will come to the Road District first.

Bill Duncan said he has been very disappointed with the County due to them taking the money away from the District. He said he would accept a write in vote.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**PETITIONS FOR DISTRICT EXPANSION** Staff said we still lack signatures for inside the District.

Jim Thomas said he had thought Chuck Davis was working on that but as soon as the weather improves he would canvas his neighborhood.

Staff said it wouldn’t hurt to get at least fifty signatures to be safe.

Bill Duncan said since we have some time now he would like to see us get one hundred signatures. He said it would show the County that we are serious about this.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**REVIEW FINANCIAL STATEMENT** Staff presented a Financial Statement showing that we have \$26,632.31.

Staff said we will discuss road projects at next month’s meeting. We will be doing the improvements to West Washington Street as soon as the weather breaks and will probably need to do an overlay in that area.

Bill Duncan said Ada Street is in need of repairs also. He said hopefully we will get an additional \$50,000 from the County.

**ADJOURNMENT** There being no further business on the agenda, a motion was made by Jim Thomas and seconded by Bill Duncan to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.
